Our Programs



MENTORSHIP

The Allie's Mentorship Program provides survivors with the one protective factor missing most after exploitation: a trusted adult who shows up consistently and offers them a healthy, stable relationship to say "you belong."

Youth survivors are purposely matched 1:1 with a trained, trauma-informed mentor for a minimum of 18-months, forming a relationship that offers belonging, reinforces safety, and builds resilience.

THRIVE

Thrive provides training, tools, resources and social connection for caregivers of trafficking survivors, empowering them with encouragement and guidance to navigate the unique needs of survivors in the context of community.

By equipping caregivers to better support the survivors living in their homes, the program contributes directly to the healing, stability, and long-term success of survivors.

Goosebump Stories

This summer, we hosted a special self-care night for the parents and caregivers in our Thrive program. Five moms gathered for a sourdough starter class, a homemade dinner, and the chance to connect with one another. Each participant went home with a sourdough starter and instructions to continue the process at home. As we reflected together, we shared the beautiful analogy that—just like the starter—small amounts of love, kindness, and care can grow into something nourishing and lasting.

One mom later shared: *"Your event could not have had better timing and just brings me to tears to be seen and to feel God's love during one of the hardest weeks of my life. It was such love and comfort to be among others who work to care for hurt people we so deeply love and want to see get well. Thanks again for seeing and supporting the unseen and for your showering of love in the bread class, meal, and gifts. I needed it more than I even knew. My heart overflows."*



This spring, one of our mentees took a brave step and began a new chapter—enrolling in school to pursue her goal of completing high school. Now, just a little over two months later, she's preparing to walk across the stage at graduation. What makes this moment even more meaningful? She invited a staff member, Amanda, to celebrate this milestone alongside her—and asked that Amanda pass a message along to several others at Allies inviting them to attend. In her words and actions, she's recognizing something powerful: she's not walking this journey alone. She has a community of support cheering her on every step of the way. This is the heart of Allies—showing up, walking together, and celebrating every victory, big or small.



On the drive home from their outing, the mentee turned to her Mentor Coach and asked, with a shy smile, "Can we turn the music all the way up and roll the windows down?" Together, they cranked up the volume, let the wind pour in, and sang at the top of their lungs. For a moment, she wasn't confined by the rules and routines of her residential facility—she was just a teenager, free and alive. It was a small act, but one that captured the joy, trust, and possibility our program creates, one moment at a time.




Just days after laying her mother to rest—and just before a planned trip out of town—a dedicated mentor made a powerful choice. She drove an hour and a half to be there for her mentee on the day she was released from the Department of Corrections. That visit wasn't just a reunion. It was a declaration: *You are not alone.* In a moment that could have been overwhelming and uncertain, the mentor's presence reinforced the trust they had built and reminded her mentee that Allies shows up—consistently, compassionately, no matter what. This act of devotion reflected the heart of our mission: relationships that go beyond convenience. Relationships that heal.



At our recent LinkUP gathering, mentors and mentees enjoyed a fun day of swimming. One mentee didn't own a swimsuit, so her mentor and CASA made sure she had options to try on. After choosing the one she loved, she surprised everyone by asking if the extra suits could be given to other mentees who might need one. In a season of life when many in her situation are focused on simply surviving, her choice to think of others showed remarkable kindness, maturity, and generosity.






